Leicester Trinity Methodist Circuit - To those interested in membership / confirmation / adult baptism sessions:

There is an opportunity to join a membership / confirmation / adult baptism course of five sessions this new year. The first will take place on Tuesday 26 Jan, 7 – 8.45pm. This will be a valuable time for those throughout the Circuit to explore questions you may have about Christian faith and what it means to belong to the body of Christ. It's also a chance to renew your faith and even bring it up to date, through teaching, discussion, and some excellent course material prepared from the Methodist resource by Brenda Wood, "Come as you are". You may feel the Spirit's stirring that it would be a good time to explore taking things a step forward, in considering membership / confirmation / adult baptism (whichever applies to you – speak to your minister if you'd like clarification on the differences between these). If you choose to participate in the short course, there's no obligation to be baptised, confirmed, or become a Methodist member – it is above all

a chance to explore your faith and sense of direction with some others on the journey. Young people are welcome to join, and they need to be in a family room with a responsible adult present in the same room.

As you can see, the first session is planned for Tuesday 26 Jan 7pm, when we can decide together the best time to meet for the future sessions. There will be the possibility of becoming a member at your local church sometime after Easter, either at an online service or face-to-face. The session themes are as below. The classes will take place on Zoom, so you'll need to be able to access Zoom, or visit someone in your bubble who can help you do this. Possibly you could join in by dialling in, but this may not feel very satisfactory.

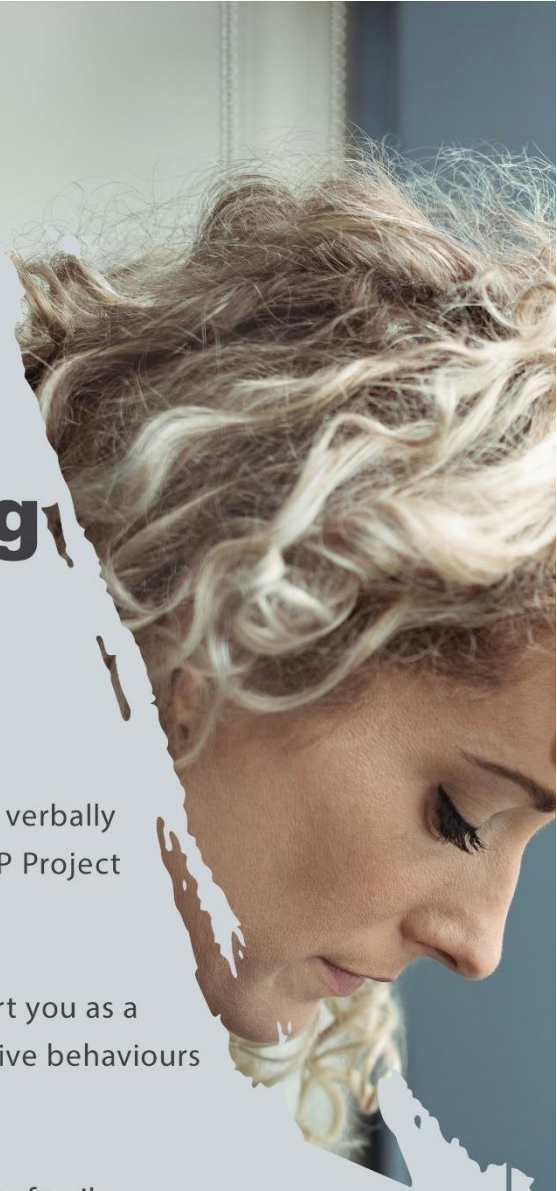
