This Sunday 28th March is Palm Sunday, sometimes called 2nd Sunday of the Passion. The Sunday morning service, at 10.30 for 10.45am is led by Rev'd Fran Rhys and will take place online. Bring a piece of bread or plain cake, with some water or tea to eat and drink together symbolically during this 'Love Feast', or Agape. This is a Christian fellowship meal recalling the meals Jesus shared with disciples. Junior Church will also provide a video drama based on the events of Jesus' entry to Jerusalem on a donkey. 
