There have been a lot of significant discussions and decisions this year. For example, on-line Communion is being trialed for 3 years, starting from 1 September, with permission of the superintendent minister, though it cannot be recorded and used at a later date. Conference has affirmed the presence of God in the relationships of co-habitees who aren't married, and from 2 September ministers will be able to conduct marriages for two people of the same sex, providing their conscience allows and the Church Council has supported this and registered this intent with the General Register Office. An Inclusive Church strategy has been adopted on the guidelines of justice, dignity, and solidarity. This work is being headed by former minister at Bishop Street, Jill Marsh.
