#### SUNDAY 14TH MAY: ANNUAL GIFT DAY APPEAL.

This is the last service that Liam Dacre-Davies is leading worship and celebrating Holy Communion before he takes a 3 month sabbatical i.e. time away from his normal work in the Circuit.

From Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> May we will be holding an exhibition of paintings by the late Alan Caine. Alan was a good friend of Bishop Street over a great many years, and we will be pleased to show a selection of his remarkable paintings. Entitled 'Patterns engraved into the earth', this month-long exhibition will focus on his landscape themes. Following on from the Alan Caine exhibition the Groby Learning

Campus, will be holding an end-of-year exhibition of student artworks.

MINISTERIAL SABBATICAL (A period set aside every seven years, for a minister to have a 3 month break from their normal duties):
Liam's sabbatical will fall due during June, July and August. He will be using his sabbatical to rest and reconnect with his family. This is the reason he has chosen to take his sabbatical over the summer (to coincide with the school holidays). The sabbatical will also provide Liam with greater time to read and write as he explores the role of doubt as a positive aspect of faith. His research will hopefully lead to the creation of devotional/worship resources."
