BENEVOLENCE FUND

As part of next week's Communion Service today, we will take an additional cash collection. This will be put into the Church Benevolence fund which enables the Church to respond to people in extreme financial need. Thank you for anything you are able to contribute.

BECOMING AN ECO CHURCH

This is a way of demonstrating that we are a church caring for God's earth. An organisation, A ROCHA, launched ECO church in 2016. They are a Christian charity committed to equip Christians and churches to bring care for the natural world into their community.

It is free to register our church. A detailed survey is being completed looking at 5 areas of church life.

On Sunday July 16th 2023 the service included a time to discuss and share aspects of our own ways of conserving resources and to think about how as a church we can help reduce and conserve the resources we need here.

The three questions we were asked to consider in the service were:

- 1. What changes have you already made in your home and ways of living?
- 2. What further changes CAN you make?
- 3. How can the church be active in conserving resources and promoting the ways in which this is being done?

If you would like to add to our survey by sending a response to Mary Gill, we will be collating the various answers in the next few days and weeks.

Once we have completed and submitted the survey we will discover whether we can achieve a Bronze award which we can display to indicate that we are an ECO church.

MINISTERIAL SABBATICAL (A period set aside every seven years, for a minister to have a 3 month break from their normal duties):

Liam's sabbatical will be running until the end of August, and in addition to using his sabbatical to rest and reconnect with his family, it will provide Liam with greater time to read and write as he explores the role of doubt as a positive aspect of faith. His research will hopefully lead to the creation of devotional/worship resources.

RIDE AND STRIDE: We will be taking part in the annual Ride and Stride Day on Saturday 9th September 2023, and are looking for a rota of volunteers to be at the Church between 10.00am and 4.00pm to record sponsored participants who arrive at the Church. The event is run by the Leicestershire Historic Churches Trust, and enables them to give grants to historic Churches that are carrying out repairs and improvements. Or, if you would be interested in taking part as a sponsored bike-rider or strider, to visit a selection of Leicestershire Churches, please speak to Robin. Half the money raised would go to Bishop Street funds, and the other half to the Trust.

On the same day, we will be opening the Heritage Room and having people on hand to talk about the history and architecture of the Church, as part of the 'Heritage Open Days'.

Named the 'God For All' training event (the new 'Justice, Dignity and Solidarity' Training), the Face to face training in the circuit may be currently fully booked.
