DEMENTIA AND SUPPORT THROUGH FELLOWSHIP: Currently in the UK, 1 in 11 people aged 65 and over are living with dementia (NHS figures.) Churches are helping those in their local community as well as in the fellowship, both those with dementia and their carers. Many have become truly 'dementia inclusive' in their meetings and services. Louise Morse works with the Pilgrims' Friend Society, a 216 year-old Christian charity supporting older people, and is a speaker and trainer at faith groups, churches, and national events. Recently she spoke at the 2023 Keswick Convention on 'The Power of Spiritual Support for People With Dementia and their Caregivers'.

VICTORIA PARK FESTIVAL DISRUPTION THIS WEEKEND "Due to the Radio 2 Party in the Park Festival at Victoria Park on Saturday 16th September & Sunday 17th September 2023, there will be various disruptions to BUS services. 31, 31A- Saturday & Sunday. Normal route until approx. 21:00. The bus will then divert via Mayfield Road, East Park Road, St Peter's. 35,000 people will be travelling on Sunday into town. There are road closures around the park including London Road from Victoria Park to the train station. Buses/cars will be diverted. Around an additional 4000 extra cars will be coming into the city with 3000 parking spaces already pre booked. Buses will also be crowded. The car drop -off is in Morrisons carpark.
