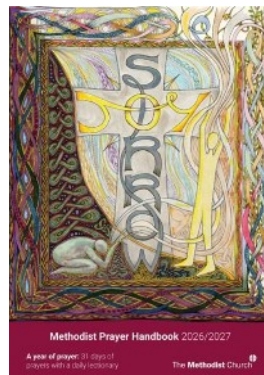
TRAINING OPPORTUNITY: **Learning to be a Facilitator. A free five week course in facilitation skills and concepts**
