Jill ministered at Bishop Street from 1993 to 1997 and she brought creativity and innovation to many aspects of congregational life and worship, such as discussing films, hosting exhibitions (for example, the banners of CND), sharing in immersive Maundy Thursday services and thinking about how we could use our premises. We will share funeral arrangements when they are announced.

**WINTER NIGHT SHELTER, ONE ROOF LEICESTER:** “Since we had to close the Winter Night Shelter in 2020 due to the Covid pandemic, we’ve been offering alternative winter accommodation each year to people who are rough sleeping. Sadly, with the rising number of people sleeping rough across the City and County, we have made the decision to reopen the shelter this winter.

This year, we will be running a static night shelter based at Central Baptist Church, Charles Street. The shelter will open from 1st December 2025 to 31st March 2026. We’ll be welcoming up to 20 guests each night, providing a safe, warm space from 9pm to 8am, along with hot and cold refreshments. We’re really excited to reopen the shelter and would be thrilled if you’d consider volunteering with us. If you have time free in the evening or overnight and would like to help our night shelter be a success we would love to hear from you.
